

Chairmans Quality Award Submission Truck "Hold" Sign

A Simple and Effective Way to Ensure All Your Products Look Great When They Leave Your Plants!

In Just 3 Easy Steps!



Step 1: Hang the Flag

After loading, a patching person places a reflective metal flag on the truck near the door.

This visual marker indicates to the driver that the load has not yet been looked over, or touched up if needed, and may not be ready for delivery to our customers.

Step 2: Prepare the load

The patching person does any patching or touch-up work needed on the load.

This flag is also useful to make sure the truck does not move while a patcher is still working on it, helping to ensure their safety.

Step 3: Release the truck

Once any final product touch-ups are completed the flag is removed. This indicates to the driver that the load is ready to get final inspection, and that...

This flagging system ensures that a driver knows when his load has been looked over and touched up if needed.

This also lets the driver know when his truck is finished so they can call for final inspection and release as required by the ACPA QCast program.
